

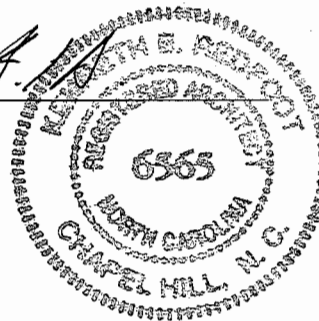

**NOTICE TO INVITED BIDDERS**

Sealed Informal, Single-Prime General Contract proposals, from contractors appropriately licensed in the State of North Carolina, will be received until 3:00pm, Tuesday, July 9, 2013, by the Orange County Schools in the Board Room of the Board of Education Building, located at 200 East King Street, Hillsborough, North Carolina for the following project:

Main Entry Improvements  
Orange High School

Following the 3pm deadline, all Single-Prime bids will be publicly opened and read in the Board Room for the furnishing of labor, material and equipment entering into the construction of the project. Bidders attending the 3pm bid opening may bring Single-Prime bids with them to the bid opening, as long as they are submitted by the 3pm deadline. Any bids received after the 3pm will not be considered. Faxed bids will not be accepted.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to deliver his/her Bid to the above-named location at the above-specified time. The Owner assumes no responsibility for bids mailed or delivered through other means. If bidder, of his own choosing, elects to mail his/her Bid, he must do so at his own risk. Such bids should be addressed to: Ms. Pam Jones, Interim Executive Director of auxiliary Services, Orange County Schools, 200 East King Street, Hillsborough NC 27516. Said bids must be identified as a sealed bid for the subject project, and should be clearly marked with the Bidder's name, address and license number.

The Orange County Schools wishes it be clearly understood that the work is to be completed as specified in the contract documents. Any bidder not able to work under the schedule outlined in the specifications should not bid the project. Submittal of a bid to the Owner will signify full knowledge of the proposed work required, the schedule, and the guarantee that the work will be performed within the time frame stipulated.

A Mandatory, Pre-bid Conference for those interested in submitting a bid will be held on Tuesday, July 2, 2013 at 10am in the main lobby of Orange High School, 500 Orange High School Road, Hillsborough, NC. A tour of the proposed project site will occur following the meeting. All prospective bidders must attend this meeting.

Contractors are hereby notified the following applicable Articles of the General Statutes of North Carolina will be observed in receiving and awarding the Contracts: General Contractor, Chapter 87, Article 1.

No Bid Bond will be required on the project. No Performance Bond or Payment Bond will be required on the project.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive informalities.

The Form of Contract used for this proposal shall be the Orange County Schools Owner-Contractor Agreement for Small Projects.
