The following clarifications/modifications are issued for the referenced proposal:

Question	Answer
Could we have an extension on the deadline?	The deadline for submittal of proposals is extended to Monday, February 5, 2018.
What is the period of performance?	The length of time that the product is relevant.
What is the length of the adoption?	The cycle of review will be at the district's discretion.
Do we have to submit answers for every question?	Submit only answers that are relevant to your product?
How do you want us to respond to whether or not we met the IMET criteria?	If your response can provide details to support our adoption, please include them. Details of responses are up to your discretion.
What format should we use to respond for each persona?	Format is entirely up to your discretion.
How many samples need to be provided currently?	Number of samples to be submitted currently is two for elementary and two for high school.
Personas for middle school students?	Consider the concept of the instructional challenge and respond appropriately based upon your product?
Can a proposal be submitted for only one grade band?	Yes! You may submit a proposal for only elementary or only high school. If there are questions that are not relevant to your grade band, please do not respond.
Is pricing required at the time of submission?	Yes. Please show us ALL pricing options.
Is this a winner take all contract?	This will be a comprehensive core resource for Orange County Schools.

Are companies required to be “licensed” or “sanctioned” by NC.	You are not required to be part of the NC DPI state approved textbook list.
How should the samples be packaged?	Access to electronic resources will be required and physical resources will help the submission.
