

The following questions have been asked related to the Orange County Schools for School Renovation Design Services, RFQ #2019-210, for several school site locations. Please see questions and answers below.

1. Have any walk-throughs been scheduled for these projects. Do you typically organize walk throughs on your projects, and if so, where is that information posted? **No, at this time walk throughs have not been scheduled as the RFQ is for project team qualifications based on similar design projects. Walk throughs can be organized for firms selected continue to the interview phase.**
2. The RFQ mentions a Capital Budget, a CIP, the Comprehensive Facility Assessment, and a Safety Assessment for Orange County Schools. When looking online I could not find either of these documents, I could only locate outdated versions. If these are available for public use, could you please share them? **All information necessary to complete projects can be provided to the selected firm at a later date. Intent of the RFQ is for each firm to showcase their team's ability to complete design services.**
3. The RFQ breaks the scope into six different projects. Will a single Design Team be awarded all projects or will these be broken between several teams? **Preferred method would be for one firm to oversee all projects; but, a collaborative effort would be acceptable.**
4. Is the County planning to select one firm for all six projects? **Yes, the preference would be for one firm to complete all six projects. But, individual project proposals will be reviewed.**
5. Is it possible to submit on only two projects found within the RFQ? **Yes, individual project proposals will be reviewed.**
6. Can the three PDF copies of the proposal be put on one flash drive or do you want three flash drives? **It is preferred that PDF copies be placed on three flash drives/cds.**
