POSTER CONTEST RULES

Instructions: Create a drawing (any size paper) that best represents the Culture, Wonder and Beauty of our Community and World. Markers, pencils, and paints are all acceptable. For older students, different mediums may also be used, such as collage, paint, pastels, graphite (pencil), charcoal, pen and ink, low relief, photography, digital art, textile, or any other medium that can be applied to a 2d surface. Use your imagination!

When creating your design think about the following: What images would best represent the culture, wonder and beauty of our community and world? Posters will be judged on the following criteria: creativity and originality of the theme, quality of artistic composition and overall design and overall impression of the artwork. All artwork must be 100% original.

Deadline for Poster Submission: Friday, February 15, 2019

Awards: Poster submissions from each of the elementary, middle and high schools will be submitted to the Cultural Explosion Committee to be judged by the OCS Board of Education. Three Winners - one from elementary, one from middle and one from high school - will be chosen to receive recognition, and their designs will be featured on advertisements for the district-wide event.

Paper Mache, Collage, Paint, Pastels, Graphite (pencil), Charcoal, Pen and Ink, digital art, textile, or any other medium are acceptable.

Awards: Masks will be displayed at Cultural Explosion in the main lobby. Three Winners - one from elementary, one from middle and one from high school - will be selected on the day of the event by designated OCS staff. Recognition and a special award will be presented to the winners at the conclusion of the event (7:30pm CRHS lobby). Following Cultural Explosion, the winning designs will be displayed at students' schools.
