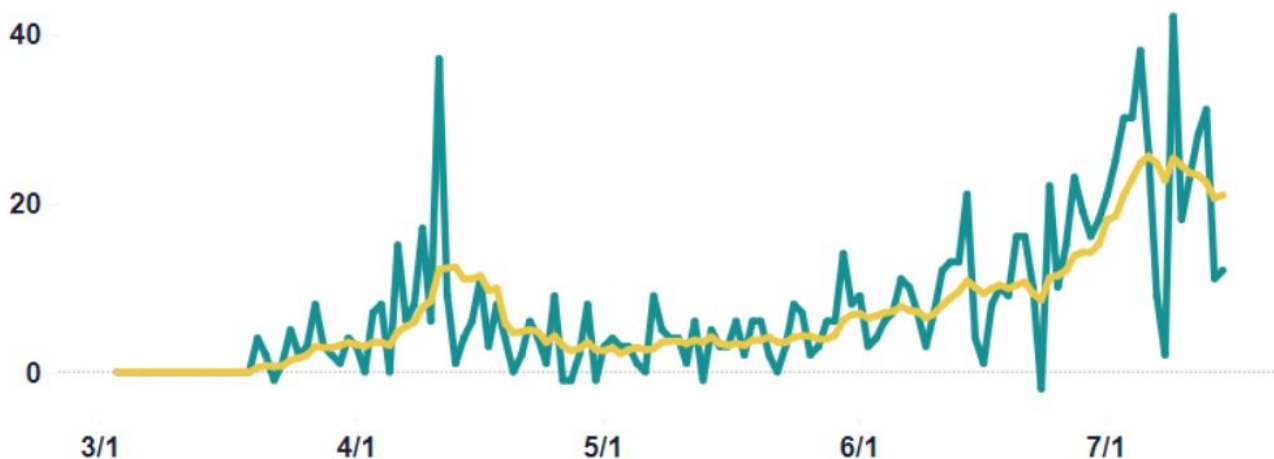




Orange County NCDHHS Statistics

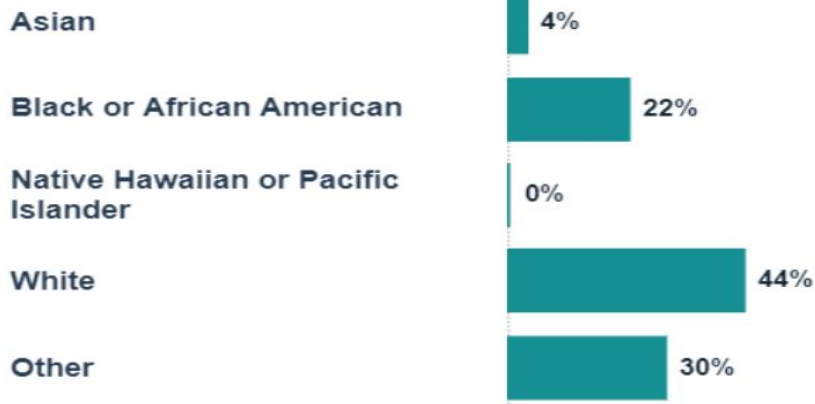

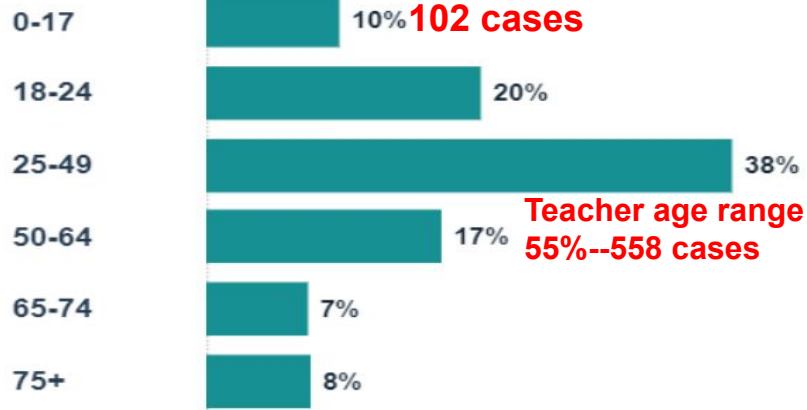

Recommendation:

1. Plan C: Remote Learning
2. Virtual Academy
3. Be ready for Plan B:
(Alternating Week)

Rationale:

- Safety and health
- Community transmissions spiking
- Wide spread; not slowing down
- Uptick in certain pockets of the county
- Not an option prior to Tuesday



Reopening Orange County Schools

Remote Learning

- The goal for remote learning is to return to the classroom for in-person learning
- Pivot to Plan B-- in-person and remote learning when safe to do so

Virtual Academy

- 100% online learning opportunity
- no in-person instruction
- Unlimited seats K-12

- Asynchronous
- Created by cross district representation of teachers
- No grading
- Limited feedback


Connected & Blended - Fall 2020

BLENDED CURRICULUM

- Synchronous and Asynchronous
- New content and grades
- Real-time engagement and feedback
- Small group instruction for students across the continuum (EC, AIG, ESL, etc.)
- Flexible and adaptable
- Created by a cross district representation of teachers

- No face-to-face instruction
- Infrequent
- Barriers to technology access

Connected & Blended - Fall 2020

CONNECTED

- Face-to-face instruction
- Required schedule/participation
- Clear communication and interaction expectations
- Daily/Weekly teacher to student and peer to peer connections
- Build community through SEL focus
- Student self assessment, reflection and goal setting
- Art, Music, PE, World Languages, CTE, STEM
- Virtual field trips

EXPLORE AREAS OF INTEREST

- Maker activities
- Independent research

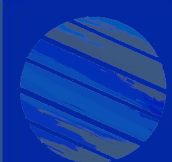
