Weather Makeup Plan for Missed Days*
1st Day: Asynchronous Remote Instruction (used 9/30/2022)
2nd Day: At-Home/Remote Instruction (May be announced as synchronous or asynchronous based on the weather event)
3rd Day: No Makeup (Banked 6 hours.)
4th Day: At-Home/Remote Instruction (May be announced as synchronous or asynchronous based on the weather event.)
5th Day: At-Home/Remote Instruction (May be announced as synchronous or asynchronous based on the weather event.)
Day 6: No Makeup (Banked 6 hours.)
Day 7: At-Home/Remote Instruction (May be announced as synchronous or asynchronous based on the weather event.)
Other: To Be Determined —Remaining teacher workdays or the 4 additional banked hours can be used for school delays due to inclement weather, other dates and times to be announced.
Note: Additional weather makeup days or times to be determined after the 7th missed day.

174 student days with a state required 1,025 instructional hours for 2022-2023. Scheduled 173.5 student days x 6 hrs = 1041 instructional hours. 16 banked hours for inclement weather = 2 banked student days and 4 hours banked for delayed openings.

Flexibility is provided within NCGS to allow for remote instruction to be utilized as part of the school calendar makeup plan when schools are closed due to inclement weather or other emergencies as authorized under state law.

* The district will continue to ensure students have appropriate assignments based on the grade and age of students. Lower elementary students in grades K-2 will have take home assignments and packets not using technology. Students in grades 3-12 will have remote instruction as announced for the weather event.
