





What is the State of Literacy Achievement in OCS?





GLP Composite by School, Elementary

College Career Ready Proficiency-Scores 4 and 5



GLP Composite by School, Middle




College Career Ready Proficiency-Scores 4 and 5




College Career Ready Proficiency-Scores 4 and 5





- Alter the relationship of the student to the teacher and the content






- Student performance is a direct result of the teaching that is going on in the classroom and the tasks that students are asked to do.


